- Based on the PPFPA, Act 5 of 2002, using MPFA, Act 56 of 2002, as well as the Broad Based Black Economic Employment Act Act 5 of 2003.
- The Nouba Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid and reserves the right not to accept any submission and to re-advertise if it so wishes.
- Bids which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted by facsimile or electronically, will not be accepted.
- Bids submitted are to hold good for a period of 90 days.
- The Bidder must be registered in Nouba Municipality Supplier Database.
- The Bidder must submit together with the bid document all relevant information requested, Valid Tax Clearance Certificate, founding statements etc see our ICB Requirements.
- Bidders that have a minimum OED of 60% or higher will be considered.
